

# Camp Men-O-Lan - DAY CAMP

## WHAT TO BRING:

Lunch	Towel for pool
Water Bottle	Insect Repellant
Modest Swimsuit	Sunscreen
Flip-flops for pool	Extra pair of shoes/water shoes
Sweater/Jacket (on cool days)	

Please label all items brought to Camp with campers first and last name.

Men-O-Lan is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Note: All lost & found will be held for 30 days, after that time it will be donated.

## DRESS CODE:

Campers must observe a modest dress code at all times. Because of camp activities, we recommend clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. Campers must wear modest one-piece swimming suits (tankinis where there are no gaps between the top and bottom are acceptable). Shorts should be suitable for recreation and not overly tight or short (the hem of shorts should meet finger tips with arms held straight at sides). Shirts should be suitable for recreation and not be revealing, overly baggy or tight. Spaghetti strap tank tops, shirts that bare the midriff and/or show cleavage are NOT permitted. Clothing with wording or images contrary to Christian principles, or wording of any kind across the back of shorts/pants may not be worn. Campers will be instructed to change if any attire is questionable.

## RULES:

Campers are responsible to protect and respect the environment and the camp facilities. This includes keeping the grounds litter-free and graffiti-free. Any and all property damage will be charged to the offending parties. Other rules set by Camp Men-O-Lan Management shall be observed. Failure of any camper to observe the camp's rules may result in expulsion.

## THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME:

The following items should be left at home and are not permitted at camp: cell phones, CD/DVD players, Ipod/MP3 players, radios, video games, computers or tablets, tobacco, lighters, alcohol, drugs, nonprescription medications, knives, or weapons of any kind. These items will be confiscated if discovered in a camper's possession.

## VISITATION POLICY:

To ensure maximum safety and security for our campers, we do not permit visitors during the camp week. In the event of any emergencies or concerns, call the Camp Office at 215-679-5144. You are welcome to drop off any important camper items left at home at our Camp Office during regular office hours, Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

## PEANUT FREE:

For the safety of those campers with severe peanut allergies, Men-O-Lan is a 'peanut free' facility. Therefore, no peanut products should be brought or sent to camp, ie: peanut butter sandwiches, candy, granola bars, etc. containing peanuts.

# DAY CAMP PROCEDURES

## Camper Check-In

**EARLY CARE** begins at 7.00AM. Any camper that has registered for early care may check in at Landis Hall (follow Day Camp signs). Breakfast is served in the Dining Hall at 8:15 AM for Early Care Campers.

**CHECK IN:** Regular camp check-in begins at 8.45AM at Landis Hall (follow Day Camp signs). If you know that you will arrive after 9.00AM, please contact the Camp Office one week prior to your arrival date so that special accommodations can be made. Check in does not begin until 8:45 AM. Please accompany your child to the registration table the first day of camp. **THE FRONT GATE WILL BE CLOSED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING REGISTRATION.** If you arrive after the gate is closed, please check in at the Office.

**T-SHIRTS:** All Day Campers will receive a camp t-shirt that will be handed out at registration the first day of camp.

**MEDICATIONS:** Please bring any prescription or over the counter medications that the camper must take during the camp day in its ORIGINAL CONTAINER. All medications must be given to the Program Director. Prescription medications **MUST** be listed on the campers health form.

## Camper Check-Out

**SECURITY MEASURES:** At registration on the first day, you will receive two copies of a name placard. Please place one copy in your windshield for pick up. The second copy is for anyone else that may be picking up your child during the week. You do not need to exit your car, a line will form in front of Landis Hall and your child will be brought to your car having been matched up with your placard. If you do not have your placard, you will be required to show a state issued form of identification (driver's license, etc.) **AND** be indicated as an authorized pick up person for the child to be released. **This includes parents of campers, please make sure you include parent's name as authorized pick up person.**
