

SUMMER CAMP JOBS 2019



Activity Leader: The Activity Leader organizes and leads the large group games in both Resident and Day Camp. They also assist with scheduling, setting up, and leading other daily activities and special events. Our Activity Leader is a creative, very energetic and fun-loving, organized person. Making Camp a fun, safe, and unique place are their top priorities. The Activity Leader has extensive experience in leading games, sport events, and activities.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Adventure Program Facilitator: The AP Facilitator runs the challenge course activities including the climbing tower, zip line, and giant swing. They plan creative ways to use these facilities every day for multiple sessions, and for various age groups. They lead general team building activities, and facilitate spiritual debriefs and discussions on life applications of activities. They may be asked to lead games for campers, and adventure activities for guest groups on weekends. The AP Facilitator has extensive outdoor adventure experience, is organized and safety oriented.

Minimum age: 19 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Assistant Cook: The Assistant Cook is the right hand of the Food Services Director. They assist with preparing, cooking, and serving meals for campers and staff. When the Food Services Director is not around, the Assistant Cook is in charge. The Assistant Cook is able to work independently, delegate tasks, lead a group of teenage kitchen helpers, and enforce all health codes and kitchen rules.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Craft Specialist: The Craft Specialist leads arts and crafts time for various camp groups. They are creative and dedicated as they plan a wide range of crafts for all ages. They are in charge of the Art Pavilion, including the arts and crafts materials. They may be asked to lead craft activities during special events. The Craft Specialist is creative and portrays excitement with each project. They are organized, independent and flexible.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Day Camp Counselors: Counselors are friends, mentors, leaders, and big brothers and sisters to the campers. They lead camp games, various camp activities, and daily Bible time. They disciple young Christians and witness to those who have not made a decision to follow Christ. Someone in this position is passionate about Jesus, lives in submission to God's Word, and desires to see young lives changed by the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Counselors have stamina, are resilient, and demonstrate emotional stability. The success of our camp ministry greatly depends on the strength of our counselors.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 17.

Day Camp Manager: The Day Camp Manager is responsible for the smooth running of Day Camp. They plan the daily program, lead events, mentor the counselors, and assist with camper and counselor needs. They work a lot behind the scenes to ensure that campers and staff have a great camp experience and they are equipped and taken care of physically, emotionally and spiritually. Camp Managers have at least three years of experience in working with children and youth. Our Day Camp Manager is spiritually and emotionally mature, energetic, flexible, and has excellent leadership skills.

Minimum age: 21 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 3 – August 17.

Head Lifeguard: The Head Lifeguard runs the waterfront activities including the pool, lake and water slide for both Resident and Day Camp. They schedule and oversee the daily work of lifeguards at each waterfront activity. The Head Lifeguard is safety-oriented, has great communication skills, and is very flexible, as the schedule may change on short notice. They stay on premises during Resident Camp sessions and support evening programs. Our Head Lifeguard must be Red Cross Lifeguard certified and have at least two years of lifeguarding experience. They oversee the lifeguard schedule for weekend groups and may be asked to guard on weekends. (Weekend hours are paid an hourly rate in addition to the weekly stipend.)

Minimum age: 19 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Housekeeper: One of our key behind-the-scenes worker is our Housekeeper. He or she is making sure that Camp Men-O-Lan is clean and attractive to campers, families, and staff. They take a big burden off of the counselors by performing daily light cleaning duties and weekly heavy duty cleaning. The Housekeeper is an organized, cheerful, and trustworthy person, who is able to follow instructions and work independently.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 17.

Kitchen Staff: Thanks to the Kitchen Staff, who prepares, cooks, and serves meals for everyone at Camp, campers and staff can eat three delicious meals a day. Kitchen Staff also cleans up the dining facility and the kitchen after each meal. Kitchen Staff members are teachable, and have good problem solving and communication skills. They must be able to lift up to 50lbs, and be on feet for long periods of time, and work fast in a fast pace environment.

Minimum age: 16 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Lifeguard: Lifeguards guard all waterfront activities including the pool, lake and the water slide for both Resident and Day Camp, including special evening events. They are safety-oriented, have great communication skills, and are flexible. The Lifeguard team cleans the waterfront areas. They stay on premises during Resident Camp sessions and support evening programs. Lifeguards must be Red Cross Lifeguard certified and have at least one year of lifeguarding experience. They may be asked to guard for guest groups on weekends. (Weekend hours are paid an hourly rate in addition to the weekly stipend.)

Minimum age: 16 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Media Specialist: Our Media Specialist captures and tells the amazing stories at Camp. They video and photograph daily camp activities and special events, creating various video projects, social media posts, and marketing material. Our Media Specialist has extensive experience in photography, video making and editing, graphic design, and Photoshop. They stay on site during the Resident Camp sessions to capture evening programs. The Media Specialist candidate is prepared to show portfolio of work at interview (pictures and videos).

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 12 – August 16.

Office Assistant: The Office Assistant works closely with the Camp Registrar, the Program Director, and the summer Leadership Team. Some of their responsibilities are checking and delivering camper mail, managing the Camp gift store, scheduling, finalizing and printing weekly reports, creating newsletters, processing camp evaluations, and assisting with various paperwork. The Office Assistant is a very organized, cheerful, and trustworthy person, who is able to follow instructions and work independently.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Job dates: June 10 – August 2.

Resident Camp Counselor: Counselors are friends, mentors, leaders, and big brothers and sisters to their campers. They lead camp games, various camp activities, and daily devotions. They disciple young Christians and witness to those who have not made a decision to follow Christ. Counselors have stamina, are resilient, and demonstrate emotional stability. The success of our camp ministry greatly depends on the strength of our counselors.

Minimum age: 18 years old by June 1st.

Resident Camp Head Counselor: This young man and young woman, mentor the Resident Camp counselors on a spiritual and professional level. They have previous experience as a camp counselor and in leading peers. They actively participate in the creative planning and leading of camp games, programs and special events. They have great passion for Jesus. Head Counselors have stamina, are resilient, and model emotional stability. They also have great communication and problem solving skills.

Minimum age: 19 years old by June 1st.
