Here is a short description of the events mentioned in the calendar. We will do our best to stick to our plans, but please note that events, trips, and the over-all schedule may change at any time due to unforeseen circumstances. We'll make our campers' time safe and fun, no matter what we do!

Scavenger Hunt Galore: Classic scavenger hunt with a few extra twists as campers settle into camp life, form their first friendships, and get to know the property.

4th of July Celebration: Come wearing red, white, and blue, and celebrate the freedom and independence of our country as we pay tribute to our forefathers.

Project: Whimsical: One of the all-camp activities during Arts & Sports week is a special collaborative art project that campers and counselors will create together.

Men-O-Lympics: There is the Olympic Games, and there is Men-O-Lympics! Teams of campers and counselors will compete in fun(ny) athletic events to win gold medals. But who will win the Big Fat Greek Cake?!

The Great Water Rally: An exciting team race through several stations, each somehow incorporating water.

Trips: Campers will be transported from Camp to the destination of the trip, participate in the event, and return to Camp promptly. Drop-off and pick-up times are not affected. For more information on individual trips, please refer to the Field Trip Disclaimers during online registration.

Family Picnic: This event is for every family who has at least one camper attending any Camp Men-O-Lan camp sessions in 2020. The picnic is rain or shine: if the weather is unfavorable, we'll gather in our spacious Gym.

Men-O-Lan's Got Talent: The well-known talent show, redesigned in Men-O-Style.

Whose Line is it Anyway?! This event will feature short skits from well-known Bible stories. Campers and counselors will participate in this special improvisation game for the amusement of our entire Day Camp.

Camper Pool Parties: These events will start immediately after regular check-out time and go until 7:30pm. We will have dinner, extra pool time, and a lot of fun. The party is rain or shine. In the event of thunderstorms, we will have a party indoors.

Christmas in July: This event will feature several holiday themed games and activities throughout the day. Ugly sweaters may earn gingerbread-points for campers!

Hunting for Treasure: This event is a tuned-up version of the camper-favorite game, Goldrush.

Western Carnival: The Carnival is back! An afternoon filled with fun carnival games, prizes, Western snacks, and good country music! As always, we'll put on our dancing boots and boogie around the field awhile!

Color War: This two-day event was last summer's favorite! Campers and counselors are sorted into teams: red, blue, green, and yellow. The teams compete in various games: some of them require athletic skills, some teamwork, some others creativity or good problem-solving skills. Parents can support their camper's team by decorating their vehicles for drop-off and pick-up, wearing their team's colors, or reciting the team chant to a Color War Coordinator!

Camp Cook-out Day: Day Camp will have lunch cooked over the grill, and we will eat outside, picnic style!

International Day: This day is a celebration of all nations and cultures. It will feature several countries represented by our local and international staff. Campers will have a great time as they learn fun or interesting facts about cultures outside our borders.

The Fantastic Masquerade: Get your costumes out because we are having a dress-up party at Camp! Campers and counselors are invited to dress up in special outfits representing story characters, superheroes, famous people from history, your favorite candy bar, almost anything! (Please make sure that both the character and the outfit are camp-appropriate, and will not be scary to younger children.)

Camper Request Day: On this special day each camper gets a chance to make a wish which counselors will do their best to fulfill. There is a fine print, but they'll get the details the day before. In short, the more creative the wish, the better!

The Great Escape: Everyone knows a great escape room. But this unique escape room-style challenge takes campers back to the first century, to the time of the first believers who were often bullied and had to escape persecution. The various puzzles and games will be solved by campers who will then be able to escape the Roman Emperor and take other believers to safety.

Staff Appreciation Day: On this special day campers will have a chance to show their appreciation to their counselors and other staff members with whom they became friends over the summer. (The counselors will not know about this event, so help us keep it a surprise until Staff Appreciation Day!)
