Position Title and Age Requirement: Adventure Program Facilitator, 19 years old by June 1, 2019

Job's Time Frame: June 12-August 16, 2019

Reports To: Day and Resident Camp Manager

Key Work Relationships: counselors, fellow Program Staff (activity, crafts, waterfront, media)

Position Summary

The Adventure Program Facilitator is responsible for running the challenge course activities including the climbing tower, zip line, and giant swing. They plan creative ways to use these facilities for multiple sessions every day, for campers from both Resident and Day Camp, and from every age group. They must have creative ideas and great communication skills. The Facilitator may lead general team building activities and facilitate spiritual debriefs and life applications of activities. They may be asked to help with other camp activities as their schedule permits.

Key Job Functions

- Plan and lead adventure programming sessions for campers multiple times a day
- Ensure camper safety at all times
- Instruct counselors on how to assist in leading adventure activities and ensure safety
- Explain, model and give clear instructions to campers during challenge activities
- Monitor and help campers complete the activity by clear communication and encouragement
- Lead constructive debriefing after activities and facilitate spiritual growth through activities where possible
- Lead or assist with weekend guest group adventure activities
- Keep challenge areas clean and orderly every day and handle camp equipment with care, keep inventory of equipment and communicate needs promptly
- Participate in special events as needed, including evening activities
- Learn and follow emergency protocol as needed
- Attend morning staff meetings and devotions
- Be in constant communication with the Camp Managers regarding daily schedules
- Assist with camp evaluation
- Other tasks that contribute to the smooth running of the ministry and a great camper experience

Experience and Qualities

- Experience in belaying and facilitating is required, current certification is preferred
- Committed follower of Jesus Christ with sufficient knowledge of the Bible
- Safety-oriented
- Creative
- Responsible and reliable, demonstrates high level of integrity
- Takes initiative and flexible
- Great communication skills
- Organized and detail-oriented
- Endurance and perseverance

Working Conditions and Physical Requirements

- Must be able to maintain leadership and emotional stability while completing tasks, sometimes with little sleep and under stress
- Ability to stay energized from early morning till evening maintaining a positive attitude
- Must be able to stand for extended periods of time and be comfortable working outdoors and at heights
