Position Title and Age Requirement: Food Services Assistant, 18 years old by June 1, 2022

Job's Time Frame: June 15-August 20, 2022

Compensation: \$200 flat rate for Staff Orientation and Training Week; \$300 per camp session worked; room and board available as part of the compensation

Reports To: Food Services Director

Key Work Relationships: Kitchen Crew

Position Summary

The Assistant Cook is the right hand of the Food Services Director. They prepare, cook, and serve meals for every camper and staff member multiple times a day. They must be able to work independently, delegate tasks, lead a group of teenage kitchen helpers, and enforce all health codes and kitchen rules.

Key Job Functions

- Prepare and cook camp meals under the leadership of the Food Services Director
- Delegate tasks and instruct Kitchen Crew as needed
- Enforce all health codes and kitchen rules
- Oversee and monitor the work of the Kitchen Crew
- Be in charge of the entire kitchen when Food Services Director is not present
- Keep inventory of equipment and food, and communicate needs promptly
- Participate in special events as needed, including evening activities
- Learn and follow emergency protocol when needed
- Carefully follow, and in the absence of the Food Services Director, enforce CDC and Pennsylvania state requirements regarding COVID-19 prevention
- Actively participate in devotions led by the Food Services Director
- Assist with camp evaluation
