They facilitate professional, spiritual, and personal growth. Head Counselors actively participate in the program planning and executing in Resident Camp.

- Develop an atmosphere where each counselor feels accepted and supported
- Get to know each counselor and how they are doing in their roles by regular check-ins, offering advice, encouragement, and prayer, and maintain a positive and healthy relationship with them
- Visit Bible time briefings and devotions, and provide constructive feedback to counselors
- Together with the Resident Camp Manager, plan, prepare and lead camp events, including evening programs, group games, etc.
- Assist program staff in leading activities and ensuring safety
- Actively participate in every camp activity, including field games, and various special events
- Assist with camper check-in and check-out, aspiring to build a positive relationship with parents
- Consistently uphold high safety standards and follow emergency protocol when needed
- Actively participate Resident Camp staff meetings
- Assist with counselor evaluation and camp evaluation
- Keep camp areas clean and assist with COVID-19 cleaning procedures
- Participate in end-of-season Resident Camp cleanup
- Other tasks that contribute to the smooth running of the ministry and a great camper experience
