- DATE:** In-person training: June 14-23;
camp sessions: June 26-August 18
- MINIMUM AGE:** 18 years old by June 24, 2023
- COMPENSATION:** In-person training: \$200; camp sessions: \$250 (first year), \$275 (second year), \$300 (third year); room and board. Weekend guarding for guest groups is paid by an hourly rate.

Our Head Lifeguard coordinates the work of the Lifeguard Team. They work closely with our Day and Overnight Camp Manager as well as the Guest Services Director to ensure the availability and safety of water-related activities. This includes evening pool parties and guest groups.

FUN

Our Head Lifeguard promotes fun and safe activities around our waterfronts and ensures that equipment is available and in great condition for these.

EXCELLENT

Our Head Lifeguard carries out their tasks, maintaining the highest standard of safety. The Head Lifeguard works with excellence to represent our excellent God and to help Camp represent Jesus and His work well.

SAMPLE LIST OF TASKS

Our Head Lifeguard runs the waterfront activities including the pool, lake and water slide for both Overnight and Day Camp. They schedule and oversee the daily work of Lifeguards at each waterfront activity. The Head Lifeguard is safety-oriented, has great communication skills, and is very flexible, as the schedule may change on short notice. They stay on premises during Overnight Camp sessions and support evening programs. Our Head Lifeguard must be Red Cross Lifeguard certified and have at least two years of lifeguarding experience. They oversee the lifeguard schedule for weekend groups and may be asked to guard on weekends.
